School history of Osnabrück

Osnabrück has a school history since

1,200 years.

- In 804 AD the Gymnasium Carolinum was founded by Emperor Charlemagne and is probably the oldest school in Germany.

School history of Osnabrück

1648 Westphalian Peace in Osnabrück and
Münster

1595 Ratsgymnasium was inaugurated, it is the
oldest non-spiritual school in the city of
Osnabrück.

„Osnabrücker Schulmuseum“ - Focus

- Focus of the collection is on the
20th century
(until about 1960).
- The exhibition and the presentation of a
historical class focus the time around
1920.

„Osnabrücker Schulmuseum“ - development

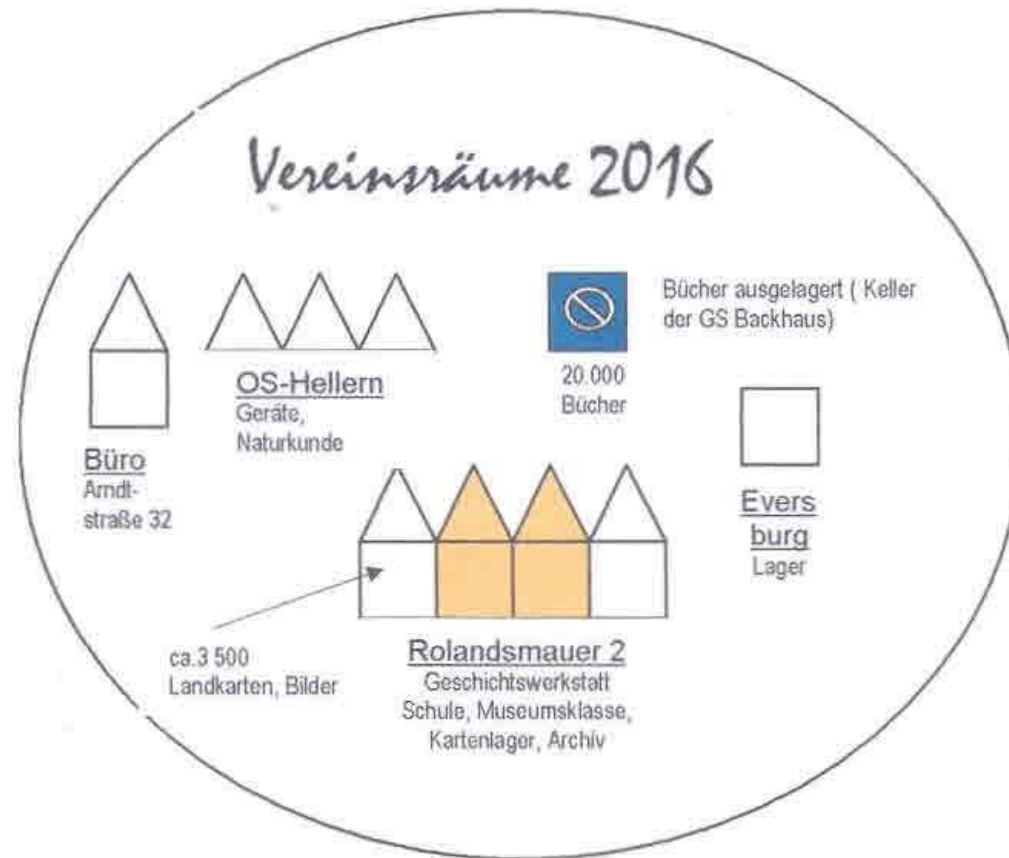
1994 first planning in the school supervisory board

1997 implementation by the current chairman

in cooperation with school leaders, school councilors and cultural officials from the city of Osnabrück.

„Osnabrücker Schulmuseum“ - collection

- maps, a total of approximately 1,500 pieces (maps, maps of history, work cards and plates on religion)
- workbenches, sewing machines, old books etc.
- episcopes, sewing and writing machines, biology models, physics and film devices, card stands, diageries and didactic materials.



„Osnabrücker Schulmuseum“ - presentation

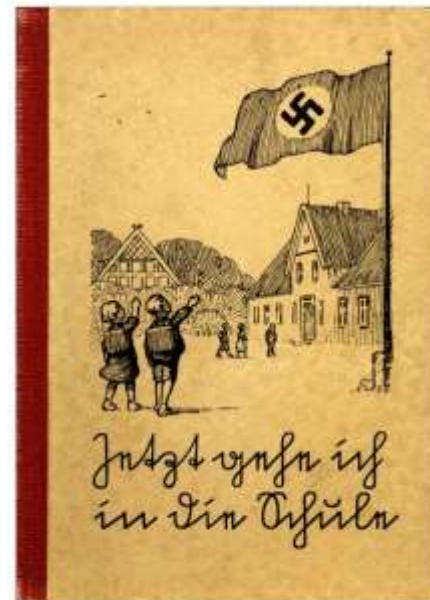
The focus is on the work in the history workshop (with a cellar archive and a class for historical lessons). The historical class shows the school atmosphere of a school of the 1920s, which could be found still in the 1960s.



„Osnabrücker Schulmuseum“ - presentation

- 22 wooden double benches with ink receptacle, black board for music notes, various slate boards, styluses, satchels, pen holders, ink, a display case with exhibits, maps, among others a Palestinian map and maps of the district, history maps, teaching materials, scientific models, further didactic materials, a teacher's table on a pedestal, a school piano, etc.
Exhibition space and place of learning for historical lessons
- The equipment follows the requirements of a decree for Prussia of 1924.

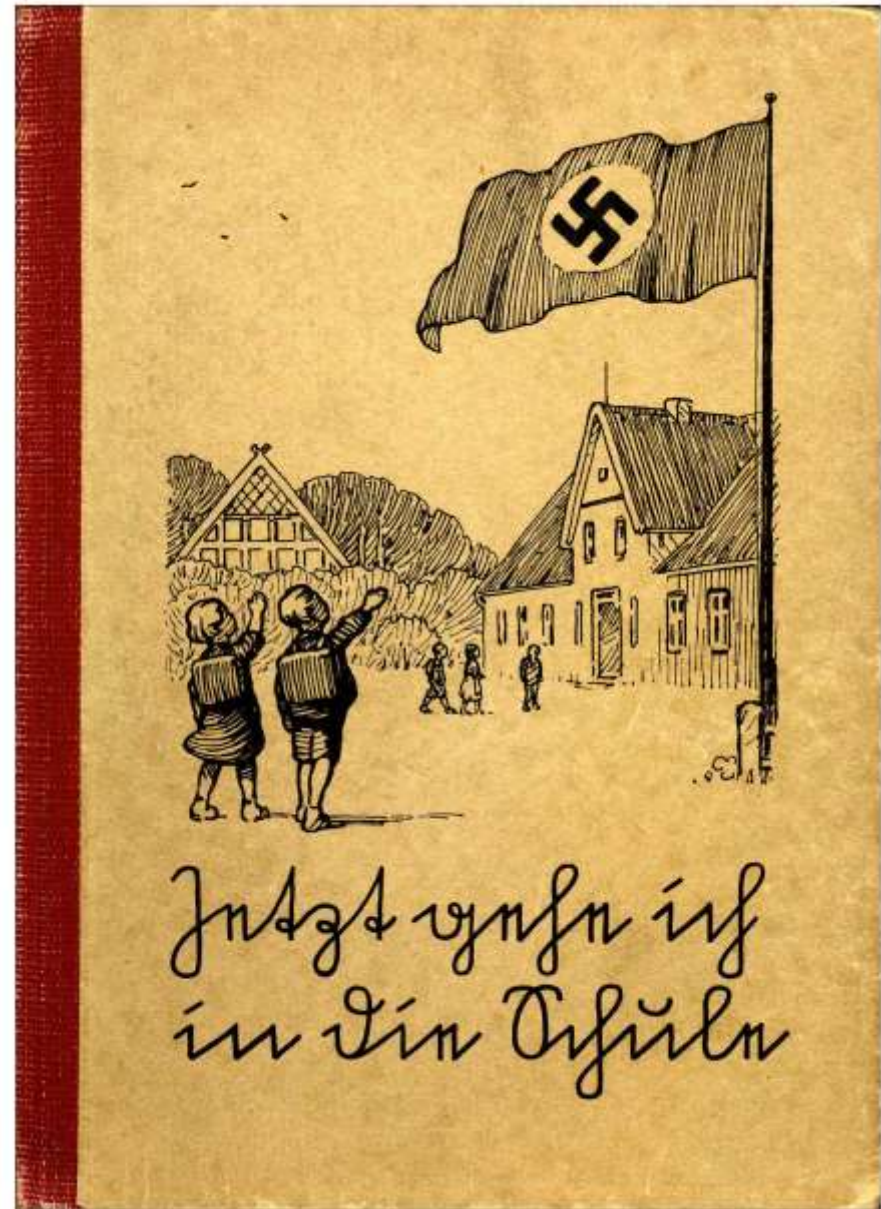

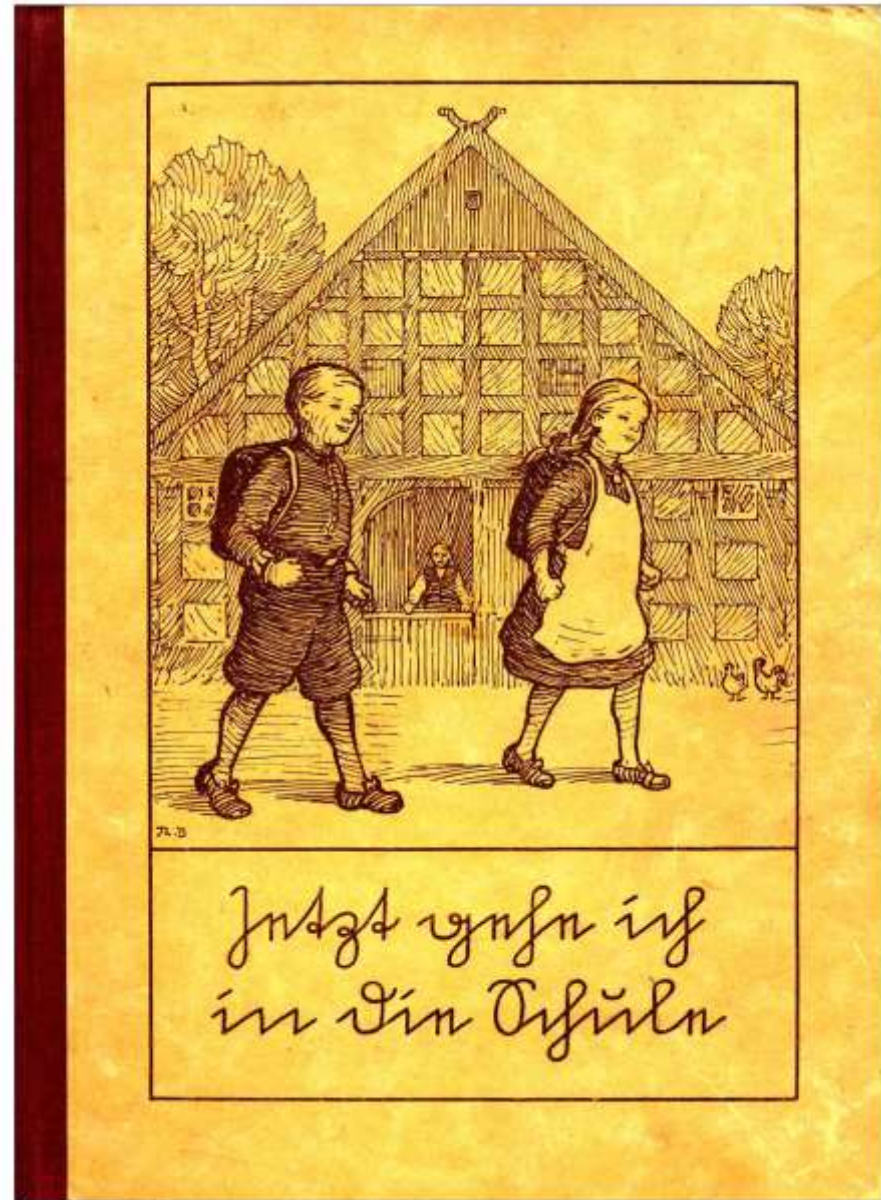

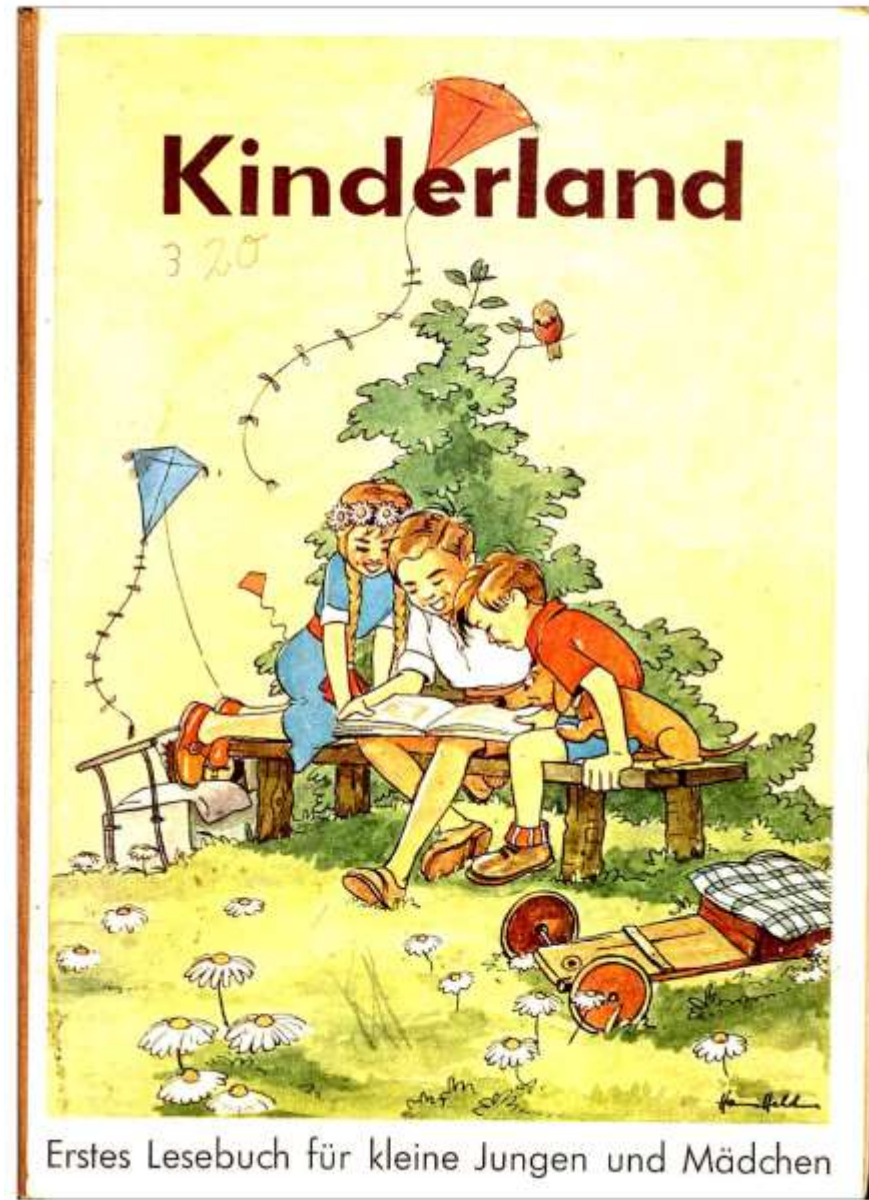
